What needs to stop?

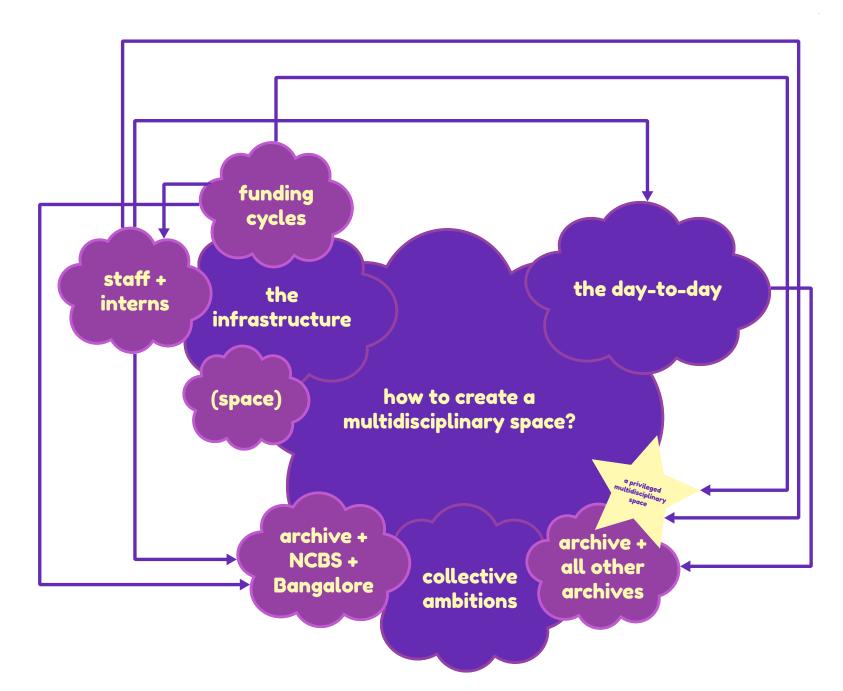
